

## Substance Use Services

- **Substance Abuse Assessment (Medicaid billable)**

Substance abuse assessments are provide to clients of all ages and are to evaluate substance use, level of functioning, levels of care, and include intensity and duration of treatment, as applicable. Standardized evaluation tools will be utilized in the assessments. Reports will include presenting problems, history of substance use, associated medical, psychological and social history of client, health, work, family person and interpersonal problems, driving record associated with substance use, past participation in treatment programs and client's attitude toward treatment. Specific recommendations will be provided in a report and may include individual services, group services or intensive outpatient services.

Services Include:

- Bio-psycho-social Assessment
- Mental Health Examination
- Specific recommnedation for treatment, treatment modality and length
- Eligible for Medicaid billing

- **Substance Abuse Treatment (Medicaid billable)**

Services will be provided by certified addictions therapist. Clinical Substance Abuse Assessments must take place prior to an outpatient program. Services will be provided to clients of all ages and will address individual substance use and any associated medical, social, psychological, vocational and legal problems. Referrals to appropriate resources will be made as applicable. Individualized recovery plans will be developed that are connected to child safety and measure for success and progress of treatment. Sample collection drug screens will be part of the services utilizing DCS contracted providers. Services may be provided for individuals, group or intensive outpatient treatment.

Service Include:

- Provided to all ages with substance related disorder
- Individual Addictions Counseling
- Group Addictions Counseling
- IOP (Intensive Out-Patient) Treatment, as applicable
- Recovery Plan with long and short term goals
- Drug Screens (Utilizing DCS contracted services)
- Eligible for Medicaid billing
