

Specialized Services

- **Domestic Violence – Survivor and Child Intervention**

Services are beneficial for clients who are victims of assaultive or coercive behavior, including physical, sexual or psychological attacks, as well as, economic coercion used against an intimate partner. Therapist will offer the provision of structured, goal-oriented, time-limited services in the natural environment of families weekly or as determined based on the needs of the family. Meetings are used to establish goals, evaluate client's preparation for and progress in meeting those goals, and to establish and build the skills necessary in goal attainment.

Services Include:

- Services will be in cooperation with local programs (shelters, law enforcement, batterers' programs, survivor programs, advocates and legal services).
- Services will be provided in individual and group settings along with casework/victim advocacy.
- Bio-psycho-social Assessment
- Individual treatment
- Group treatment as available
- Safety Planning
- Coordination of services
- Crisis Intervention 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

- **Sex Offender Treatment (Medicaid billable)**

Services are set up to reduce the risk of reoccurring sexually based offences. Office appointments are scheduled for individual sessions as appropriate for the specific diagnostic tools and evaluations being utilized for each client. The assessment focuses on identification of abnormal, antisocial or deviant patterns of thoughts, feelings and behavior. The assessment also focuses on identification and understanding of situations and the learned experiences and processes that might have led to abuse-related behaviors and their maintenance and/or likelihood of repeated behaviors. This information will be used in appropriate formulation of treatment interventions. Goals will be established through identification of client/family strengths and challenge areas. Specific therapeutic models and skills utilized will be determined as appropriate for meeting the needs of the client. Meetings are used to evaluate client's preparation for and progress in meeting goals, and to establish and build the skills necessary in goal attainment. The Counselor will develop individualized activities to address the client's needs.

Services Include:

- Risk and Needs Assessment, including the ERASOR Assessment tool
- Establishment of a Containment Team
- Individual, group and family components
- Polygraph testing
- Relapse Prevention, if appropriate
- Family Support services
- Compliance monitoring and reporting.
- Eligible for Medicaid billing
