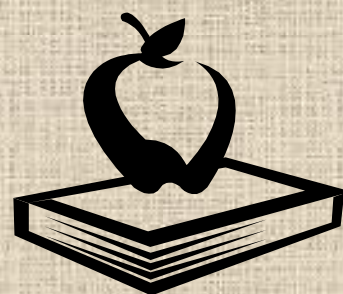


Tutoring/Literacy Classes

- Tutoring/Literacy Classes- provides daily supervision of students who have been identified to need help in academic or literacy performance.
- Length of service: 6 months -1 year, Monday through Friday up to two hours of service per day.
- This program will serve children in grades 1-12.
- Target Population:
 - Families who have substantiated cases of abuse or neglect and will likely develop into a IA or CHINS
 - Families that have an IA or CHINS or JD/JS
 - All adopted children
- Eligibility Criteria
 - Those established in the service standard
 - Children who are behind their grade level with their basic educational skills.
 - Children who are at or above their grade level with their basic educational skills.
 - Children in need of supervision during after school hours.
- Services Provided
 - Caring youth-adult support/relationships
 - Skill development
 - Family engagement
 - Supportive of school/youth partnership
 - Academic assessment
 - Individual educational plan
 - Study sessions specific to each child's needs
 - Group sessions covering topics of interest
 - Participation of educator in Family Team Meetings
 - Monthly update/progress reports
